BRAGGING RIGHTS RULES

1. The Bragging Rights Match is a scratch event, with each Senate entering only members from their Senate.
2. Only the scores bowled with your senate teams can count toward bragging rights.
3. The hosting senate will pay for Bragging Rights Match. **Only those who signed up for the senior's division must be 55 or older to qualify, and can only bowl on the senior team.**
4. Senates will be responsible for selecting their Bragging Rights Teams (male team, female team, male senior team, and female senior team with a minimum of 3 female bowlers). **Teams must wear their respective senate shirts.**
5. One game position round. The one game total will determine each Senate's position for the Championship Brackets format.
6. Brackets Format: 4th position bowls 5th position, 3rd position bowls 6th position. Winners of the two matches advance to next bracket. The lower seed winner will bowl 1st position and the higher seed winner will bowl 2nd position. Winners of these two matches will bowl for championship. In case of a tie, there will be a one frame roll-off (tenth frame format).
7. The Senate of the winning team will receive "the Bragging Rights Trophy" to be held for one year.

MIXED TEAM GAME RULES

1. All entrants must show proof of their TNBA and USBC 2016-17 Membership. **No TNBA membership cards will be sold at tournament site.**
2. This tournament will be a Handicap Mixed Team Event. **Teams will consist of five members from their Local Senate with at least 1 member from the opposite sex. Not more than three players on the same team can place more than once in the Prize List for position standings – USBC Rule 315B.** Handicap will be figured individually for each bowler at **90% of 220 scratch.**
3. Entry deadline is **Monday, June 5, 2017.** Senate payment should be received no later than 2 week after.
4. Entrants must use their highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 games or more for the 2015-16 season. **NO SPORTS OR SUMMER LEAGUE AVERAGES** may be used. If no 2015-16 book average, entrants must use their 2016-17 current average of 21 games or more as of the date of participation. League sheet or signed verification from the bowler league secretary must be submitted prior to bowling. If none of the above, the bowler must enter on a 220 scratch average. Average book, yearbook or bowl.com is considered official for final averages. **THE 10 PIN RULE IS IN AFFECT.**
5. **Entry Fee is \$175.00 per team:** \$35.00 per person (Lineage - \$10.00; Prize Fund - \$17.25; Expense Fund - \$3.50; Party Fund - \$3.25; and Kitty - \$1.00).
6. All entry forms and fees must be submitted through your Local Senate Coordinator. No entry fee will be returned except in dire emergency such as a strike, lockout, fire, etc., over which management has no control.
7. Prize money will be returned 100%: Team – 80%; Individuals – 20%.
8. **Prize Ratio Teams – 1 in 8: Individuals – 10** places each for males and females. Individual awards consist of Handicap High Game, Scratch High Game, Handicap High Series and Scratch High Series. Under no circumstances will a bowler qualify for more than one award in the same category (categories being games and series). Example: High Game Handicap and High Game Scratch.
9. All teams and individual prize money will be awarded after the conclusion of the Teams and Bragging Rights Events on Saturday night at the Match Play Party.
10. All teams must check-in one hour prior to scheduled squad time. Tardy players will start in frame being bowled and shall receive a **zero** for each frame missed. No vacancy score, blind score or pacers will be permitted.
11. **Bowlers must bowl in the order listed on the original entry form.** Infraction of this rule will result in disqualification if the team captain fails to comply.
12. **Substitutes will be allowed and must bowl in the position of the original entrant. A substitute must be a member of the Six Sponsoring Senates.**
13. The Match Play Championship will be determined by the Senate with the greatest total of handicap pin fall based on a three game series. The winning Senate must have a minimum of twenty **(20) Teams** to qualify for the Kitty Fund and Trophy. Each Senate must use the scores of the first twenty **(20) Teams** entered. If the minimum is over 20 Teams, that number will be used to qualify for the Kitty Money.
14. Entrants may bowl on more than one team. Best game and series shall count toward individual awards.
15. **USBC Rule 319a-3 applies. Failure to use the proper average** prior to the completion of the first game will result in disqualification of the entire team. **USBC Rules 319d and 319e have been waived.** Averages will be verified by the Senate Coordinators and the Host Senate Director before participation.
16. The Senate Coordinators reserves the right to re-rate any bowler and accept or reject any or all entries and will decide all questions and disputes arising in the Tournament and his/her decision will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with **USBC Rule 329.**
17. **Professional Bowlers:** No current members are allowed. Past champions may be permitted to bowl if their championship was not within the last 10 years. Former members who have not held a card for the past 2 years are eligible to bowl.
